

**The following organizations can assist a military veteran with brain injury:**

1. [Department of Veterans Affairs](#) - The Department of Veterans Affairs provides a wide range of benefits including disability benefits, education and training, vocational rehabilitation and employment, home loan guaranty, dependent and survivor benefits, medical treatment, life insurance and burial benefits. 2. [Vet Centers](#) provide individual, group and family counseling to **all veterans who served in a combat zone.**

3. [Defense and Veterans Brain Injury Center \(DVBIC\)](#) - The **Defense and Veterans Brain Injury Center (DVBIC)** treats service members and veterans with mild, moderate or severe TBI, and helps them from the moment of injury to their return to duty or reintegration into the community.

**DVBIC**

develops, provides and distributes educational materials for both military and civilian providers, families, service members and veterans.
